Introduction

Scripture Reading: Romans 6:15-23

Invitation Song: "I Am Resolved"

- 1. This is the time of year that many people pause to think about and make resolutions for the new year.
 - A. Others don't ever bother with it.
 - 1) Perhaps they know that they will never be committed to whatever resolution they make.
- 2. But, if we think about it, Christians ought to be resolution making people.
 - A. The sayings of Jesus and the apostolic letters are all about His followers resolving to make changes in their lives.
 - 1) That certainly is the meaning of repentance.
- 3. As a new year begins, let's make some resolutions ourselves.
- 4. Let's take a look at words from our hymnal, "I Am Resolved."

I Am Resolved No Longer to Linger, Charmed by the World's Delight

- 1. The world that we live in has a lot to offer.
 - A. Pleasures and recreation are everywhere around us.
 - 1) Many strive for all the fun and enjoyment possible.
 - 2) However, in many cases, what one grabs for soon grabs us!
- 2. What should our response be to the world's delights?

 1 John 2:15-17
- 3. Peter reminds us of the fate of the world and our response.

 2 Peter 3:10-14
 - A. There are things higher, nobler to aspire to than merely the material and sensual pleasures of this world.

I Am Resolved to Go to the Savior, Leaving My Sin and Strife.

- 1. The reason we, as Christians, go to the Savior is simple.
 - A. Peter said:

John 6:68 But Simon Peter answered Him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life."

- B. Everything He says is geared toward making us more holy and devoted to our heavenly Father.
- 2. That means we must be resolved to live sinless lives.
 - A. It is unfortunate that some people think "I can always repent tomorrow"

James 4:14, 17 Hebrews 3:12-13

- 3. Sin, willful or otherwise, is the great separator of man and God.
 - A. We must strive daily to make sure we put it all behind us!

I Am Resolved to Follow the Savior, Faithful and True Each Day

1. There is no one else that can offer what Jesus offers to us.

Acts 4:12 Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.

- 2. He is all authority, all powerful, all loving and is our only hope for our full and final victory!
 - A. But victory will only come if we resolve to live diligently Devoted to Him in COMPLETE obedience.

Hebrews 5:9 And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him

Colossians 1:21-23

Revelation 2:10 ".....Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life."

- 3. All these speak of DAILY faithfulness, not a "Sunday morning only" Christianity!
 - A. Just as He is faithful to us, He desires consistent faithfulness to Him.

I Am Resolved to Enter the Kingdom

- 1. This, dear brethren, is what it's ALL about.
 - A. We, as Christians, have a hope and longing for heaven!

John Dyer:

"A man may go to heaven without health, without riches, without honors, without learning, without friends; but he can never go there without Christ."

"HEAVEN - Don't miss it for the world!"

2. This is a resolution that must take priority over ALL else.

Matthew 6:33 But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

- A. We must have determination, firmness, and stability in our decision to walk daily with Christ.
- 3. We WILL be met with opposition, maybe even from those whom we love, but we must be resolved to remain strong!

 Matthew 10:32-39

2 Timothy 3:12 Yes, and all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution.

A. There will certainly be a cost to our discipleship but the rewards will outweigh anything that we must endure.

Romans 8:16-18

Conclusion

- 1. Won't you be fully and completely resolved to live for Christ?
 - A. Each one of us must make this decision for ourselves.
 - B. The right decision followed by the right action will result in salvation!
- 2. As we sing this invitation song, let the chorus remind you of the blessings of your resolve.
 - A. Be "glad and free!"
